The Winter Session for Elementary Activities will begin on Monday December 10. Please return the last page of this letter to your child's classroom teacher by Monday, December 3. Winter Activities will end March 8. All Elementary activities end at 4:00 PM with the exception of the Family House activity. Please note that we have after-school busing for students involved in the after-school activity program. Students have **two weeks** to decide to participate in after-school activities. **After two weeks, students are no longer allowed to add activities and must wait for the next session.** Students who have more than **two absences**, do not participate or do not cooperate in the activity they sign up for will be asked to drop the activity.

Monday

Read Aloud Club

Grades 1-2, Sponsored by Ms. Scilla. Do you like listening to a good story? Do you wish to rest and relax after a full day of school work? Do you want to hear a story about a little mouse, or a swan, or a pig? An E.B. White or Beverly Cleary story will be read aloud in this club. Stuart Little, The Trumpet of the Swan, Charlotte's Web, or The Mouse and the Motorcycle. On the first day, we will take a vote. If this sounds like fun for you, join the club. (Space limited to the first 10 students who return their form).

Tennis Club

Grade 1, Sponsored by Mr. Misha, & Ms. Lindsay. Students may sign up for either Monday or Thursday Tennis. Students need to bring their own tennis racquets. Come and improve your tennis skills. This activity is limited first 10 students.

This will be an open studio and students will be able to bring their ideas and projects to work on with guided support, including access to all of our Studio resources and supplies. Fencing Club

Grades 3-5, Sponsored by a Cyprus Fencing Federation Coach. We are happy to inform you that the Cyprus Fencing Federation will be sending a fencing coach to teach students interested in this sport. Join in and learn about this exciting sport. Limited space.

Digital and Non-Digital Storytelling Club

Grades 3-5, Sponsored by Ms. Christina. Students will use Story bird as their tool in order to write their own stories and they may have the chance to listen to different stories and retell them.



ELL Homework Club

Grades 3-5, Sponsored by Ms. Dana. This club is recommended for students enrolled in ELL in grades 3, 4, and 5. Students will need to bring their homework and /or class work for extra support. Emphasis will be on English Language, reading, writing, and math skills.

Clash of Clans Club

Grades 3-5, Sponsored by Ms. Stacey. Have you always wanted to be the boss of a town? You can! Join us and learn how to play the strategy game Clash of Clans. You will be using your own iPad, bring it in. We will download the game and we will learn how to play this strategic game.

Homework Club

Grades 3-5, Need some time to catch up on your work? How about doing some reading on Raz-kids? Then Homework Club is the place for you! Join us and have some fun while getting your daily homework done or working on iPads for math and reading practice. Choose the day that works best for you!

Tuesday

Boys and Girls Sports Club

Grades 1-2, Sponsored by Mr. Morales. This is a fun sports activity for students interested in playing different sports such as football, volleyball, kickball, lacrosse, American football etc. Each week, students will be experiencing different sports.

Tennis Club

Grades 3-5, Sponsored by Mr. Misha & Ms. Maria. For beginners and students need to bring their own tennis racquets. Come and improve your tennis skills.

Gymnastics Club

Grades 1-3, Sponsored by Ms. Eva. The club is for beginners. Students will learn tumbling moves on the floor mats. This is a necessary skill to acquire before they can move on to more complicated stunts. Practicing such moves will constitute a huge part in building one's ability to perform other techniques smoothly and attain correct body posture. Students will be learning to do forward and backward rolls, balance activities, hand stands and other skills.

Mosaics Club

Grades 4-5, Sponsored by Ms. Katerina. Students will be learning how create mosaics in a simple, fun and interesting technique that will make it enjoyable for students.

Origami Club

Grades 1-5, Sponsored by Ms. Antonia. Students will be learning to make origami crafts, the art of paper folding. Students will be doing creative projects.

Reader's Theater Club

Grades 2-4, Sponsored by Ms. Wendy. What is reader's theater? It's a fun way to read our favourite stories out loud, like a play. In Reader's Theater, students "perform" by reading scripts and acting out plays created from favourite story books, like Elephant & Piggy by Mo Willems. In this club, students will act out favourite stories, and write own plays based on their favourite books. (1st graders can join in if they have reading skills of at least a Level F).

Chinese Language and Culture Club

Open to Grades 1-5, Sponsored by a teacher from the Confucius Institute from the University of Cyprus. We recommend that students commit to all 3 after-school activity sessions as each one will build on the skills from the previous session. This will be a year-long activity. This is a great opportunity for AISC children to learn aspects of the Chinese language and culture and to be able to see the progress they make during the year. There will be a cost of 75 euros for each of the 10-week sessions and this includes materials. We will need a minimum of 7 students to be able to run this activity for the year.

Yoga Club

Grades 1-5, Sponsored by Ms. Sylvana. Feeling tired after a long school day? Join this club for a fun activity that will help you calm you down and boost your focus and confidence.



Boys and Girls Basketball

Grades 3-5, Sponsored by Mr. Dave. Join in to learn and practice the game of basketball. Students will learn to improve their skills.

Cribbage Club

Grades 3-5, Sponsored by Mr. Feutz. Cribbage is a card and board game that teaches critical thinking while reinforcing basic math facts. You collect points by combining cards together to make runs or scoring combinations. Cribbage is also a game of strategy and tactics. Sometimes you try to score points, sometimes you try to stop your opponent from scoring; every game is subtly different. This game helps develop awareness and skills in multiple forms of counting, complements, combinations, sequences, patterns, and even probabilities. It is a great game to help build creativity and patience as well as teamwork and cooperation.

Homework Club

Wood Wizards

Grades 2-5, Wood Wizards. This activity is delivered by the "Family House" located in a 2 - minute drive from the school. Students will meet in the picnic area and an AISC staff member will drive the students to the Family House (using the AISC bus). Parents must pick up their child at the **Family House, 8 Kastoros Street, 1087 Nicosia (22-262900)** from the end of the activity. The activity will be from 3:30-4:30pm. This is an old classic coming back! A STEM favourite, the Wood Wizards Workshop teaches students hand-on skills, while thinking about shape, size, contrast, comparisons, spatial relationships and problem-solving in a practical approach. The Family house trusts its students to work with real, children-sized tools. While the Wood Wizards provides children with an inspiring means to become makers, tinkerers and engineers, safety is always emphasized. Over the 10 weeks, children will be introduced to safety rules, tools and their properties As their skill levels increase, they will move forward to increased tool usage and will be creating exciting projects. Children will get to take home their finished projects! No need for prior experience. Please note that families will need to pay a cost of 110 euros pre-paid for the ten-week session (45 euros per month) directly to the Family House

The program of CRC Campus Clubs will be tailor made to respond to the general and specific needs of AISC. At the end of the year the children participating will be named as Young Ambassadors of "Hope for Children" CRC Policy Center.
