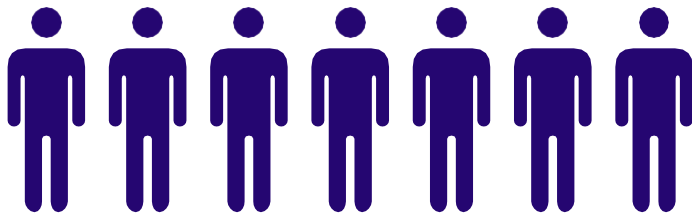

- American High School Diploma with the International Baccalaureate Diploma (both qualifications)

- Each student's curriculum individually customized to the best academic fit for the student.

High School Curriculum

- 180 instructional days; 2 semesters; grade reports are issued each quarter and at semester end.
- All High School academic courses are taught at a university-preparatory level.
- Honors and Advanced Placement classes are not offered.
- Grade 12 students enrolled in the IB Diploma program are required to take the IB exams in May.
- Students not enrolled in the full IB Diploma program have the option to take IB exams for Course Certificates.

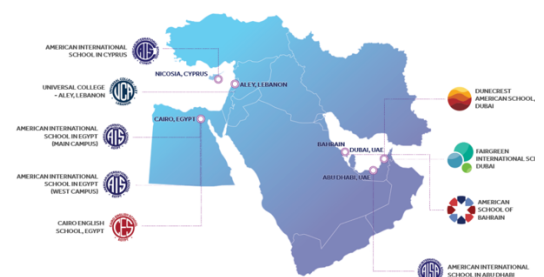
